Instead of rushing to answer this question, please use it (and the other four questions in this article) as a guide for prayer and meditation in the weeks to come (**Proverbs 3:5-6**). As we enter the season of fall, we will be presented with many opportunities to become more grounded in God. Christian education classes will be offered in abundance and I hope you will find one that accommodates your schedule. If you are part of a team or ministry, you will be asked to begin all decision-making discussions with prayer and scripture reflections.
